## **Charlie Jackson Academy Director**

Charlie has worked with some of the finest young footballers during his 25 years in coaching. Coach Jackson has forged a world-class reputation within coaching circles, due to his record of signing young players to Category 1 Academies.

A high number of these players have gone on to sign professionally for clubs such as Manchester United, Blackburn Rovers, Preston North End, Liverpool, Everton, Burton Albion, Villarreal in La Liga, along with Real Salt Lake and New England Revolution in the MLS and a number have also been selected to represent their national teams such as England. Scotland and Kenva.

Previously, Charlie also gained his international honours by accepting the invitation to join the Scottish FA setup, by way of becoming a development coach for the Scottish FA Regional Centre, again held at Moorland's training facilities. The latter being the only one of its type outside of Scotland.

Charlie has earned plaudits on both sides of the Atlantic, as well as from the senior staff at UEFA and European giants Ajax of Amsterdam.

Charlie has also held coaching roles within the Academy setups of Blackburn Rovers, Manchester United and he is currently the Manchester City FC Head Development Centre Coach.





## **Frequently Asked Questions**

#### WHAT AGE GROUPS DO YOU COACH?

We cater our coaching sessions for a variety of age groups ranging from Juniors as young as 8 through to Seniors up to the age of 19.

### WHAT ENTRY CRITERIA DOES MY CHILD HAVE TO MEET?

We put great emphasis on a good attitude to learn, to develop and to get the best out of yourself. As long as you have a genuine interest in football, paired with a good work ethic, you can apply for a place.

## CAN MY CHILD ATTEND WHILST AT CLUB LEVEL ACADEMY?

This is often common practice to maximise the football exposure a child has. We have several students who are also signed with Cat 1 Academies and attend Moorland for education.

## WHAT CAREER PATHWAYS AND OPPORTUNITIES DO YOU PROVIDE?

Students who attend the Academy will usually be signed to CAT 1 Academies, before moving into professional careers. Any student who chooses to take up a non-playing career is guided through several sports and coaching options.

## HOW IS EDUCATION AND FOOTBALL SPLIT AT THE ACADEMY?

On the BTEC course students can expect to experience a minimum of 10 footballing hours a week with our coaches, delivered alongside a tailored curriculum. Academy students from Juniors through to GCSE will have up to 6 hours dependant on their personal tailored programme of study.

#### WHEN CAN MY CHILD MOVE TO MOORLAND?

We welcome applications all year round and our course delivery can be adapted to ensure any later additions can be fully brought up to speed in a timely manner.

## DO I HAVE TO PASS A TRIAL OR ENTRANCE EXAM TO JOIN?

Simply put the answer is, no. Our only criteria is that any student joining must have a good attitude to learning and being the best they can be. The vast majority of students complete a free taster week to ensure they are a suitable fit for the Academy.

## IS THE ACADEMY LARGELY ATTENDED BY INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS?

Our Academy caters for a balanced mixed of UK and International students, often with students attending the Academy, representing their countries at a international level.

### HOW MUCH CAN I EXPECT TO HAVE TO SPEND ON KIT EACH YEAR?

Dependent on student growth a full kit for the year usually starts at around £150 excluding boots. Usually our students can comfortably get two years out of a single training kit.

## IS BOARDING PREFERABLE TO MAXIMISE DEVELOPMENT AT THE ACADEMY?

Boarding allows students to spend extra time engaged with the game, as well as allowing the students to form strong bonds with their peers and get used to the day to day familiarity of a football career. Being a close group allows them to push each other to achieve the most they can out of every day.
