Scotland and Kenva.

Charlie has also held coaching roles within the Academy setups of Blackburn Rovers, Manchester United and he is currently the Manchester City FC Head Development Centre Coach.

BTEC Level 3 in Sports Coaching and Development Combined with A-Level Study

Our BTEC programme is intended for post-16 learners planning to either progress directly into employment in sports coaching and development role or suited to those wishing to progress to higher education with sport. The combined two-year programme of study in Sports Coaching & Development can be tailored to your learning journey alongside one or two A-Levels.

On this qualification you will have access to:

- Tuition from UEFA A and B Licensed Coaches.
- Excellent pastoral, academic and social support.
- Superb training facilities and partnership opportunities with Blackburn Rovers FC and on-site Manchester City FC Development Centre run by Moorland Head Coach.
- Opportunities to train and play semi-professional football.
- 100% success rates for course completion and progression onto university.
- Two international football trips*



The 2-year combined programme of study in Sports Coaching & Development:

We can deliver courses equivalent to one/one and a half/two A-levels.that are 360, 540 and 720 guided learning hours respectively through a variety of units.

In addition to this programme students will receive the following aspects as part of their personal development experience:

- A two-week FA Level 1 Licensed Coaching Course.
- Have 1 full day release at Blackburn Rovers FC Category 1 Academy participating in education, training and gym work.
- · Participate in daily elite training sessions.
- Participate in daily gym-based fitness sessions, following a structured fitness programme.
- Play competitive football in the English Schools and College Football League and enter three cup competitions.

What does this qualification cover?

The areas of study on our course allow learners to develop their technical skills, underpinned by knowledge developed in consultation with employers and professional bodies. Combining this with our experienced coaching staff it gives students an excellent opportunity to translate the skills and knowledge they learn to a career within the sports industry.

With a delivery that consists of a wide range of units, this course allows students to consider employment in varying areas such as coaching, working towards delivering a sport curriculum in schools or even running their own coaching company. This qualification also offers learners the opportunity to progress to further study and higher education being equivalent to one/one and a half or two A-Levels which would be combined with one or two additionally studied A-Levels.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS & ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Personal Learning Journeys Tailored for a Career in Sport

Entry Requirements

Our courses provide a vocational alternative to A-Levels and the opportunity for successful students to progress to higher education. We also ensure that pathways are available for students to study a combination of vocational and traditional qualifications. Students are aged 16 or over and the following requirements are needed:

BTEC Level 3 Extended Certificate (360), BTEC Level 3 Foundation Diploma (540) and BTEC Level 3 National Diploma (720)

An English GCSE at C (4) or higher plus a minimum of three others at C (4) or higher, including Maths or Science.

Education Progression

As a course equivalent to A-Level the Level 3 BTEC Diploma is an ideal spring board for progression to a Foundation Degree or Full Degree depending on UCAS points gained. Successful students may progress to higher education courses such as:

- FdSc Sport Coaching and Performance
- FdSc Strength and Conditioning
- FdSc Sports Coaching
- A range of BA and BSc undergraduate degrees

These Foundation courses require a minimum of 48 plus UCAS points dependant on entry criteria for each individual university establishment.

Learning & Assessment

Achievement in the qualification requires a demonstration of depth of study in each unit, assured acquisition of a range of practical skills required for employment or progression to higher education, and successful development of transferable skills. Learners achieving a qualification will have achieved across mandatory units, including external and synoptic assessment.

Internally-assessed units are assessed using a grading scale of Distinction (D), Merit (M), Pass (P), and Unclassified (U).


There are no formal examinations on the Level 3 BTEC. Assessments will include assignments, presentations and reports.

Career Opportunities

Employment opportunities in Sport and Exercise and its related industries are currently very good. The Extended Certificate, Foundation Diploma, Diploma and Extended Diploma Sport Studies provides the qualification and experience for entry into the industry at an operational level with future prospects for management. Upon starting your course our coaches will plan and advise on your own bespoke pathway based on your career aspirations.



Frequently Asked Questions

WHAT AGE GROUPS DO YOU COACH?

We cater our coaching sessions for a variety of age groups ranging from Juniors as young as 8 through to Seniors up to the age of 19.

WHAT ENTRY CRITERIA DOES MY CHILD HAVE TO MEET?

We put great emphasis on a good attitude to learn, to develop and to get the best out of yourself. As long as you have a genuine interest in football, paired with a good work ethic, you can apply for a place.

CAN MY CHILD ATTEND WHILST AT CLUB LEVEL ACADEMY?

This is often common practice to maximise the football exposure a child has. We have several students who are also signed with Cat 1 Academies and attend Moorland for education.

WHAT CAREER PATHWAYS AND OPPORTUNITIES DO YOU PROVIDE?

Students who attend the Academy will usually be signed to CAT 1 Academies, before moving into professional careers. Any student who chooses to take up a non-playing career is guided through several sports and coaching options.

HOW IS EDUCATION AND FOOTBALL SPLIT AT THE ACADEMY?

On the BTEC course students can expect to experience a minimum of 10 footballing hours a week with our coaches, delivered alongside a tailored curriculum. Academy students from Juniors through to GCSE will have up to 6 hours dependant on their personal tailored programme of study.

WHEN CAN MY CHILD MOVE TO MOORLAND?

We welcome applications all year round and our course delivery can be adapted to ensure any later additions can be fully brought up to speed in a timely manner.

DO I HAVE TO PASS A TRIAL OR ENTRANCE EXAM TO JOIN?

Simply put the answer is, no. Our only criteria is that any student joining must have a good attitude to learning and being the best they can be. The vast majority of students complete a free taster week to ensure they are a suitable fit for the Academy.

IS THE ACADEMY LARGELY ATTENDED BY INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS?

Our Academy caters for a balanced mixed of UK and International students, often with students attending the Academy, representing their countries at a international level.

HOW MUCH CAN I EXPECT TO HAVE TO SPEND ON KIT EACH YEAR?

Dependent on student growth a full kit for the year usually starts at around £150 excluding boots. Usually our students can comfortably get two years out of a single training kit.

IS BOARDING PREFERABLE TO MAXIMISE DEVELOPMENT AT THE ACADEMY?

Boarding allows students to spend extra time engaged with the game, as well as allowing the students to form strong bonds with their peers and get used to the day to day familiarity of a football career. Being a close group allows them to push each other to achieve the most they can out of every day.

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
